Traveling with your pooch? Good! We love dogs too. Here are just a few of the places in Everett you can visit with your four-legged friend.

Start the day by walking your pup along the [1. PORT OF EVERETT'S WALKING PATHS](#) also known as [THE MILLTOWN TRAIL](#). You'll enjoy the lovely views and salty sea air, and your pup will enjoy taking in all of the new smells.

For lunch, we recommend the vintage vibe of [2. RAYS DRIVE-IN](#), an old-school Everett drive-in famous for their fish 'n' chips, shakes and burgers.

Take a short drive along Mukilteo Boulevard to [3. JAPANESE GULCH](#) (1099 Mukilteo Ln.) where you'll find a mud-free, off-leash dog park and lots of forested hiking trails that will tucker you both out.

Head to [4. MIDDLETON BREWING](#) (607 SE Everett Mall Way, Ste. 27-A) where dogs are welcome and treated like part of the fam. Introduce your pup to the owner's two dogs, who are always roaming around (they even have their own little dog houses). Middleton's spent-grain pizzas and sandwiches are A+, by the way. Vietnamese restaurant Pho 36 is about five minutes south. We recommend the chicken or beef sandwich banh mi.

Finish the day by catching a sunset at Everett's beautiful park/popular dog hangout, [5. GRAND AVENUE PARK](#). Tons of locals walk their dogs here, and it is Everett's best sunset viewing spot.
